Discussions

- Looking to sort Hall hire at Cumbernauld Village Hall for the ongoing weekly meeting of the club
- Want to have hire confirmed and sorted ASAP. Hope to have first club night last week in January/first week in February 2023.
- Club Bank account setup not being complete could delay. Should we use personal account for time being to be sure to get started. Committee to call NLC on opening on the 4th to submit details and get the ball rolling. In lieu of club bank details being ready to use personal bank account for the initial payments.
- Contact NLC about heating at hall and ETA on fix
- Richard raised idea of a soft launch with committee only to test venue to understand workings before opening to the public
- Chris details all progress of social and web. Discusses blog and future engagement along with committee responsibilities for socials and engagement going forward.
- Discussed terrain progress and availability. Agreed dealing with this was a major priority.
- Meet and greet/floor walkers. Discussed how this might work on club nights. Should implement a rota for this responsibility perhaps
- Richard raised idea to push the bus stop on socials and web. Once village hall confirmed club will need to address wayfinding to the club
- Simon raised idea that first club night should be a 1500point game with a random opponent out of the hat rather than prearranged games.

- Started discussion on how game arrangement in future can be facilitated. The idea that facebook is forward facing but people should be filtered to discord for discussion and arranging games.
- Richard raised idea of LFG (looking for group) channel for people who maybe don't have games but would like one, or would prefer to avoid games with certain members (in the event of personality clashes/don't like the way they play/hard fits)
- Simon raised that he intends to start an escalation league soon after launch to bring up newer players and build on enthusiasm.
- Introduction nights discussed. Anyone playing their first intro games could play for free.
- Idea of having a few club armies/kill teams/warbands for those new to the hobby and club.
- Other games discussed. Idea of bringing other games along (BSF, Cursed City etc).
- Potential to look for a DM for DnD.
- All present members voted unanimously for Chris Mooney to hold the position of Club Chair for 2023. Daniel and Stephen also voted for Chris by proxy.
- All present members voted unanimously for Simon Lewis to hold the position of Club Treasurer for 2023. Daniel and Stephen also voted for Simon by proxy.
- All present members voted unanimously for Curtis Walker to hold the position of Club Secretary for 2023. Daniel and Stephen also voted for Curtis by proxy
- Time to broach partnership and awareness of club to Castle Comics

Actions

- Committee member to call NLC and organise hire of hall ASAP for the last week in January (Thursday 26th)/ NLC re-open after festive period on 4th of January
- If club bank account not available yet personal account to be used in interim to secure. Committee to each transfer funds to facilitate cost. Cost calculated equally.
- ALL to perform detailed stock check of terrain and mats etc. detailed inventory of everything to be added to google doc including progress and condition. This is so potential shortages can be identified and resolved as needed ahead of launch.
- RICHARD self-nominated to talk to Greg Findlay of Castle Comics about the club and potential partnerships and possibilities.
- ALL to push and engage in discord discussions and growth
- All to ramp up community building and engagement by getting involved in Facebook/discord/blog
- TEST: Simon to try a short video or reel and send to Curtis for editing
