### **Discussions**

- Hall hire at Greenfaulds Community rooms confirmed. Number of tables requested 15. Confirmed hall hire for 6 weeks, Chris already submitted booking form.
- Visual timeline required for socials and club members so people know where the club is at any given time.
- 10<sup>th</sup> Edition Warhammer boxset released End June. How many to buy. Boxset for the club to form starter armies for new people to the game. Intro armies.
- Club requires more boardgames. Potential to offer this choice up to the club members, one new per 6 weeks? Set aside budget for this. £700
- Both Marvel Crisis Protocol (MCP) and Star Wars Shatterpoint (SWS) considered big and popular systems. Lots of interest. Core sets for the club? Costs of these £70 and £120
- Intro games for new members and people to the hobby. Warcry considered a great entry point. New Starter set due to be released soon from Games Workshop. Club Copy? £110-£130
- Club requires first aid kit.
- Hobby corner for painting and modelling proving very popular. Want to support and build on this. Ideas for club purchases in this area. Glue, brushes, paint set (army painter), paint station, and lamps?
- Bolt Action intros. Drive for more historical and grounded based games. Very popular
- More 3D printing supplies required to print more terrain (FDM)
- More boxes required for additional terrain.

- Tournament practice table. A table to emulate competitive tournament setups so that competitive minded gamers can practice using proper competition terrain. Square based terrain pieces.
- Chris is building a gothic themed terrain. Curtis is building a daemon/possessed themed terrain.
- MCP & SWS scale and themed terrain required. 1 board for each?
- New mats required for new games systems 3ftx3ft. 3 or 4 additional 6x4ft mats for club. Committee to start to be returned their own borrowed mats.
- Goblin gaming sale on mat bags
- New events. Invite in commission painters to do tutorials. Teach occasionally. (new attendee does this). Lots of enthusiasm for this idea.
- Weekend events, Carronade & Claymore. North Lanarkshire price for weekend hire could be problematic. £700 for Saturday hire, £800 for Sunday. More investigation of costs of this Idea. All really keen on pushing this for next year potentially.
- Bloodbowl beginner league. Concern that not enough interest. Committee primary driver. Potentially cut for now and revisit.
- “The Wall” proving very popular so far. Lots of enthusiasm from member. Continue.
- Narrative 40k campaign to start circa September once 10<sup>th</sup> edition has bedded in. Simon is mid writing. Terrain required. Fallen Titan themed “Steal the Titans Soul
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> edition Warhammer campaign discussed.
- Necromunda campaign. When to start? Interest?
- Castle Comics. How to foster relationship. Potentially frosty at the moment. Committee dedicated to supporting Friendly Local Game store where feasible.

- Secure 10<sup>th</sup> Edition Boxset for the club £150
- Create first multiple choice boardgame list for members to vote on. (end of June?)
- MCP core set £70 and SWS core set £120 to be purchased
- New Warcry set to be purchased on release
- MCP Terrain set created (Curtis)
- SWS terrain set created?
- First Aid Kit Purchased
- 3D Printer FDM Sourced
- 3x3 Space mat, 3x3 MCP appropriate mat & 3x3 SWS mats purchased.
- 3 or 4 additional 6x4ft mats purchased.
- Contact select commission painters to gauge interest and costs of event
- Finish writing Titan Campaign (Simon)
- Titan terrain to be designed and printed (Chris & Curtis)
- Gauge interest for old edition 40k campaign (Richard)
- Tournament table. Source good terrain files etc for board. Square bases etc (Stephen & Simon)

- Bolt action intros and community growth when Dan returns to a more regular schedule (Daniel)
- Hobby Corner Supplies. Source (ALL)
